Our pupils come from all over the world. Children and young people with different languages of origin learn together. Our classes are mixed year groups up to and including Year 8.

Individualised support

We promote key skills such as creativity, independence, the joy of discovery and a spirit of innovation. Secure skills in cultural techniques (reading, writing, maths) and digital media equip children and young people for future challenges. The multi-professional team draws up individual learning and support plans.

Cultural education

Music, art, theatre and dance - cultural education is an important pillar of our everyday school and after-school care. It enables holistic learning and non-verbal forms of expression.





Diversity

Educating everyone to be open-minded, democratic, peaceful and tolerant is particularly important to us. For us, diversity means enrichment! Our pupils are encouraged to take responsibility and stand up for others by taking on social tasks and in the subject of commitment.

Multilingualism

From Year 1, the children learn about the different languages at the school in our language workshop. From Year 3 to Year 10, English has a fixed place in the weekly timetable. English is also promoted in integrated language learning (CLIL) in the subjects of biology, geography, art, music, theatre and sport. Pupils can learn at least two foreign languages at our school. After English, they choose French or Spanish from Year 7 onwards. Alternatively, they can take English Plus or German Plus. Newly immigrated pupils receive special language support in German as a second language (DaZ) and language-sensitive subject lessons.

Career prospects and potentials

In addition to basic economic, social, technical and legal knowledge, pupils receive intensive career guidance. From year 5 onwards, they experience the various occupational fields in practical days, internships and vocational workshops.

State school-leaving qualifications in years 9 & 10 (Quali, successful secondary school leaving certificate, intermediate school leaving certificate) and the Abitur at our partner school Montessori Fachoberschule open up all academic and career prospects.

Our future workshop offers older pupils the opportunity to catch up on their school-leaving qualifications and supports our alumni in the transition from school to work.





All-day school and multi-professional team

In addition to the teaching staff, the school and after-school care team includes school social workers, psychologists, curative educators and many other specialists. They support the pupils in their learning and personal development. Our inclusive after-school care centre and our open all-day school are integrated into the school day from Monday to Friday.
